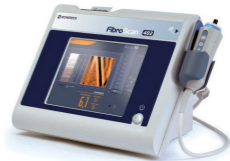


Access to a **free** FibroScan® through ECCQ

- ECCQ provides free FibroScan® services for migrants and refugees who have Hepatitis B or Hepatitis C.
- Hepatitis B or C can cause liver cirrhosis and liver cancer.
- FibroScan® is a fast and painless test for the liver to check for cirrhosis or damage. It is safe for almost all people. It can replace liver biopsy which is a painful and longer procedure.
- Your GP has to refer you to the service.



Process for GPs to refer patients for a **free** FibroScan®
