RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Social Support (taking them shopping, attending medical appointments, social functions for aged care)
- Domestic Support (housework, cleaning, vacuuming, making beds, mopping floors)
- Personal Care (showering, toileting, dressing, nail care, etc)

SKILLS & REQUIREMENTS:

- Must have own transport to travel to client homes (reimbursed at 92c per kilometre between clients)
- Police Clearance (can be applied for)
- Recommended Cert III in Aged Care, but not essential
- SCHADS Award rate of \$29.71 per hour plus 11% Super
- Shifts during weekdays (during normal working hours) to suit your availability

TRAINEES:
