## Submission Guidelines:

- Your artwork is required to be designed specifically for use as a background. It can be submitted in either vector or raster format and must be appropriate for display at A1 size (7,016 x 9,933 pixels).

- With your submission, include a concise description that outlines how your artwork captures the themes of the conference.
- If your artwork is in raster format, ensure it is of high-resolution quality, at 300 dpi, to maintain clarity when scaled to A1 size.
- The deadline for artwork submissions is the 11th of March 2024.
